Focus On Filters:

Filters are essential to your air conditioning system.

Air contains particles; some seen and not seen. Air conditioners draw particles such as dust and bacteria into them when heating and cooling.

Air filters help remove these particles before they can be breathed in.

Dirty filters need to be changed periodically in order to maintain healthy indoor air quality.

Regular inspection of your filters is also beneficial in the proper functioning of your air condition unit.

Not changing the filters can cause your equipment to use more energy than normal; resulting in higher costs.

Incoming particles insulate the coils causing your A/C unit to run longer to cool an area because the coil is insulated.

Before turning on your A/C unit this summer it's important to check your registers and ductwork.

First the registers: Make sure that there are no rugs or furniture obstructing the airflow.

Open them up and see if anything has gotten into the ductwork that could cause problems.

Second the ductwork: If you see debris or mold in your ducts it's time to clean your ductwork.

Cleaning your air ducts is an effective way of eliminating the spread of germs and airborne bacteria--resulting in your home having improved and healthier indoor air quality and your system will function cost effectively.

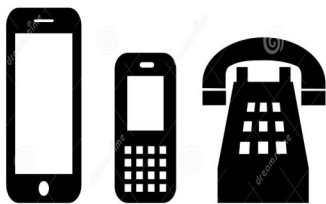
